Museum of the Moon, by the artist Luke Jerram, is coming to Southwell Minster this Autumn.

Measuring seven metres in diameter, the Moon will hang majestically in the Nave of the Minster.

We're expecting to attract over **12,000 people from all over Nottinghamshire and beyond** – in 2023 we hosted Gaia, a huge representation of the Earth, which 11,300 people came to.

We'll be hosting several events under the Moon, including early morning Pilates sessions, 3 days of school workshops run by our friends at the National Space Centre, and a fabulous night of drinks and dancing, *Moonshine*.
