Messiaen *L'Ascension*

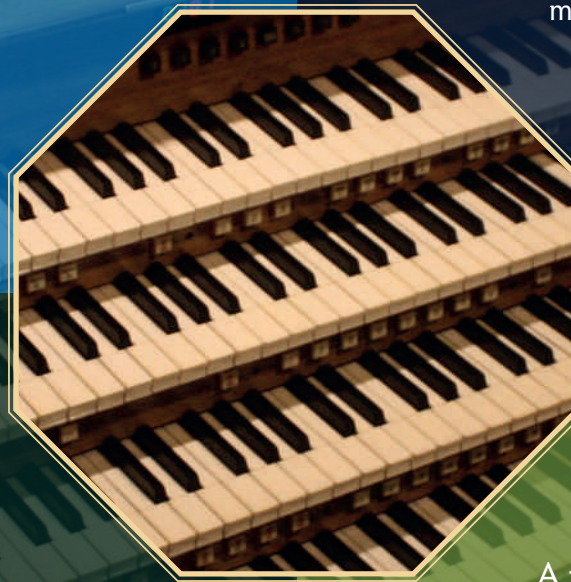


**Sunday 20 December (4.30pm)**
